The District Superintendent of Schools serves as the chief executive officer of the Putnam/Northern Westchester and the Southern Westchester Boards of Cooperative Educational Services (BOCES) and the liaison between the New York State Commissioner of Education and local school districts. BOCES was established in 1948, but statutes from as far back as 1910 still prescribe certain responsibilities of District Superintendents.
